

Census of Prison Population July 2014. – Cell occupancy – In-Cell Sanitation

Information on the numbers of usable cells in each institution, the number of cells that accommodated one, two, three and four or more prisoners, prisoners without access to in-cell sanitation and prisoner who were required to use toilet facilities in the presence of others.

The **key statistics** from this section of the Census are:

- There were **4,003** prisoners in custody
- **1,978** (49%) prisoners were accommodated in single cells
- **789** cells accommodated 2 prisoners (1,568 prisoners)
- **111** cells accommodated 3 prisoners (333 prisoners)
- 30 cells accommodated 4 or more prisoners (124 prisoners)
- **330** prisoners (8.%) were required to slop out
- **1,610** prisoners (40.%) were required to use the toilet in the presence of another prisoner
- **2,063** (52%) prisoners were in a single cell with a flush toilet or had access to toilet facilities in private at all times.
